

On May 08, 2017, Officer Cheek received the Positive Policing Award from ASIS International. According to their website, ASIS International is "the preeminent organization for security professionals. Founded in 1955, ASIS is dedicated to increasing the effectiveness and productivity of security professionals by developing educational programs and materials that address broad security interests." ASIS International recognized Officer Cheek's creation and implementation of the Griffin Project, where Officers visit city schools and interact with children with special needs.

Police Chief Billy Grogan stated, "Police officers have no greater responsibility than protecting the most vulnerable people in our communities and building relationships with them. The Griffin Project does just that."


