What is a Resident Catering License?

 A Resident Catering License authorizes the provision of alcohol at events, functions or special event facilities outside of your business's current fixed location within the city.

- Handle the intake and processing of all resident catering license applications. They can help you check if you already have a current pouring permit or beverage license.

Prerequisite Licenses - Do I need any other licenses?

 Yes, your business must first have a valid beverage license from the city to sell or otherwise dispense alcohol at a fixed location within Dunwoody in order to apply for a Resident Catering License. If you do not already have one, you will also need a Pouring Permit (which will require a Background Check).

~ Fees - What are the Fees?

The Administrative Fee is \$50 per application regardless of the type of alcohol (beer, wine, and/or liquor). The Resident Catering License is \$50 per day of the event. Should you need a Background Check for a Pouring Permit the fee for the Background Check is \$50 and the fee for the Pouring Permit is \$60.

Multiple Events - Do I need a Resident Catering Permit for each Event?

 Yes, O.C.G.A. 3-11-2 and 3-11-4 require separate applications for each off-premises catering permit.

Sunday Sales - Do I need Sunday sales license for a catered event on Sunday?

Yes, your business must first have a valid Sunday sales license or a One Day Sunday
 Sales Permit in order to apply for a Resident Catering License for a Sunday.

Types of Alcohol – Does the type of alcohol served under a Resident Catering License need to match the type of alcohol for which my business has an existing license?

Yes, your business must first have a valid alcohol beverage license for the sale of each type of alcohol you intend to serve as with a Resident Catering License. That is, if your business processes a license only to sell malt beverages at your fixed location in the city you may only sell or serve malt beverages at the authorized catering event or function.

Excise Taxes – Are excise taxes imposed on the sale of liquor with a Resident Catering License?

 Yes, excise taxes are imposed upon the total of individual drinks of distilled spirits served by a resident caterer and shall be paid within 30 days after the conclusion of the catered event or function.
