### Methodology

### Survey Methods


- Randomly distributed postcard survey
- Distributed geographically
- Open-link online survey for anyone not in random mailing (962 returned)

### Survey Response

- 3,000 surveys randomly distributed to residents
- Final sample size was 661 (22% return rate, +/- 3.8% margin of error)








### **ACCESS POINTS – BROOK RUN PARK**

### **VEHICULAR ACCESS – BROOK RUN PARK**


Pros:

### PEDESTRIAN ACCESS – BROOK RUN PARK


Pros: Sidewalk connection along N. Peachtree Rd.

Pedestrian access lacking on Barclay Rd. & Peeler Rd.






### PEDESTRIAN ACCESS – BROOK RUN PARK






### PEDESTRIAN LINKAGES – BROOK RUN PARK

Opportunity for better linkage to West & North






### **ESTABLISHED INTEREST AREAS – BROOK RUN PARK**



Cons: Invasive plants








