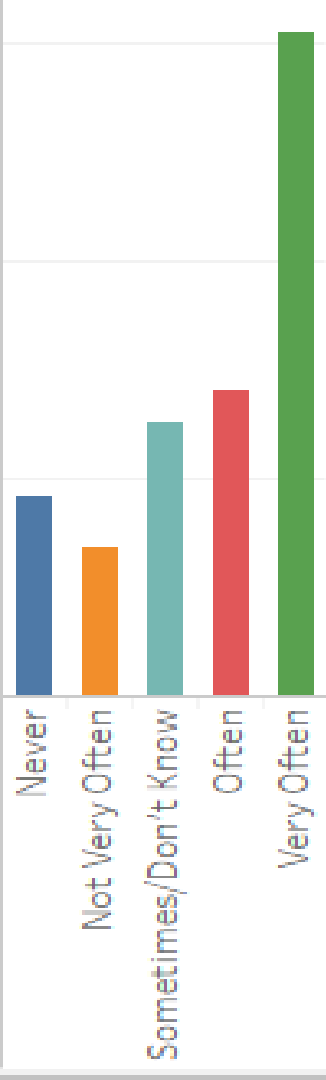

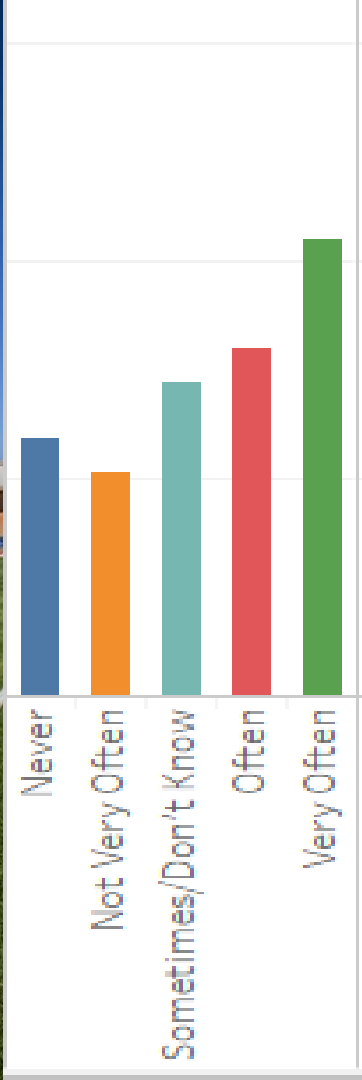


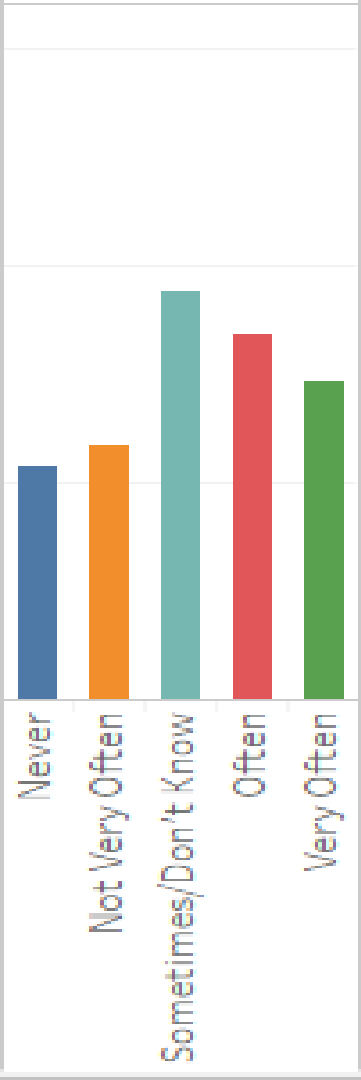

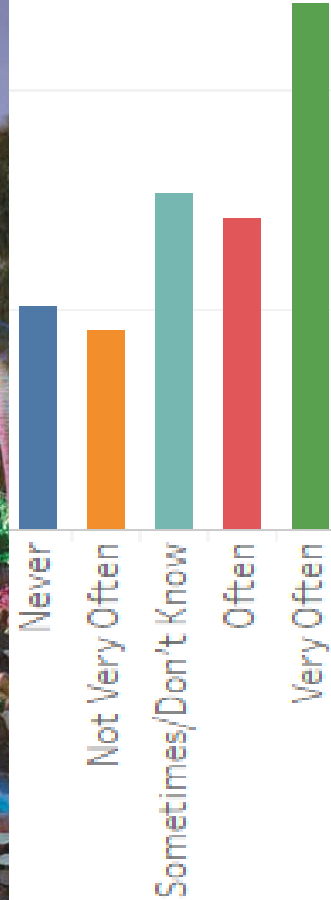

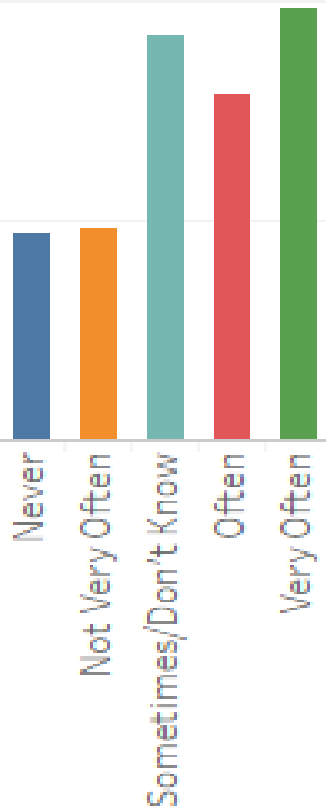

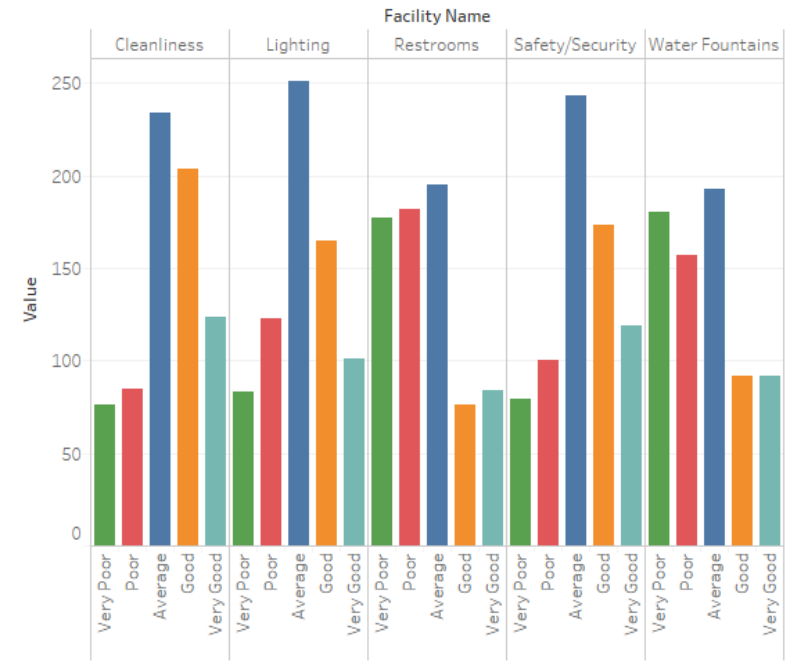

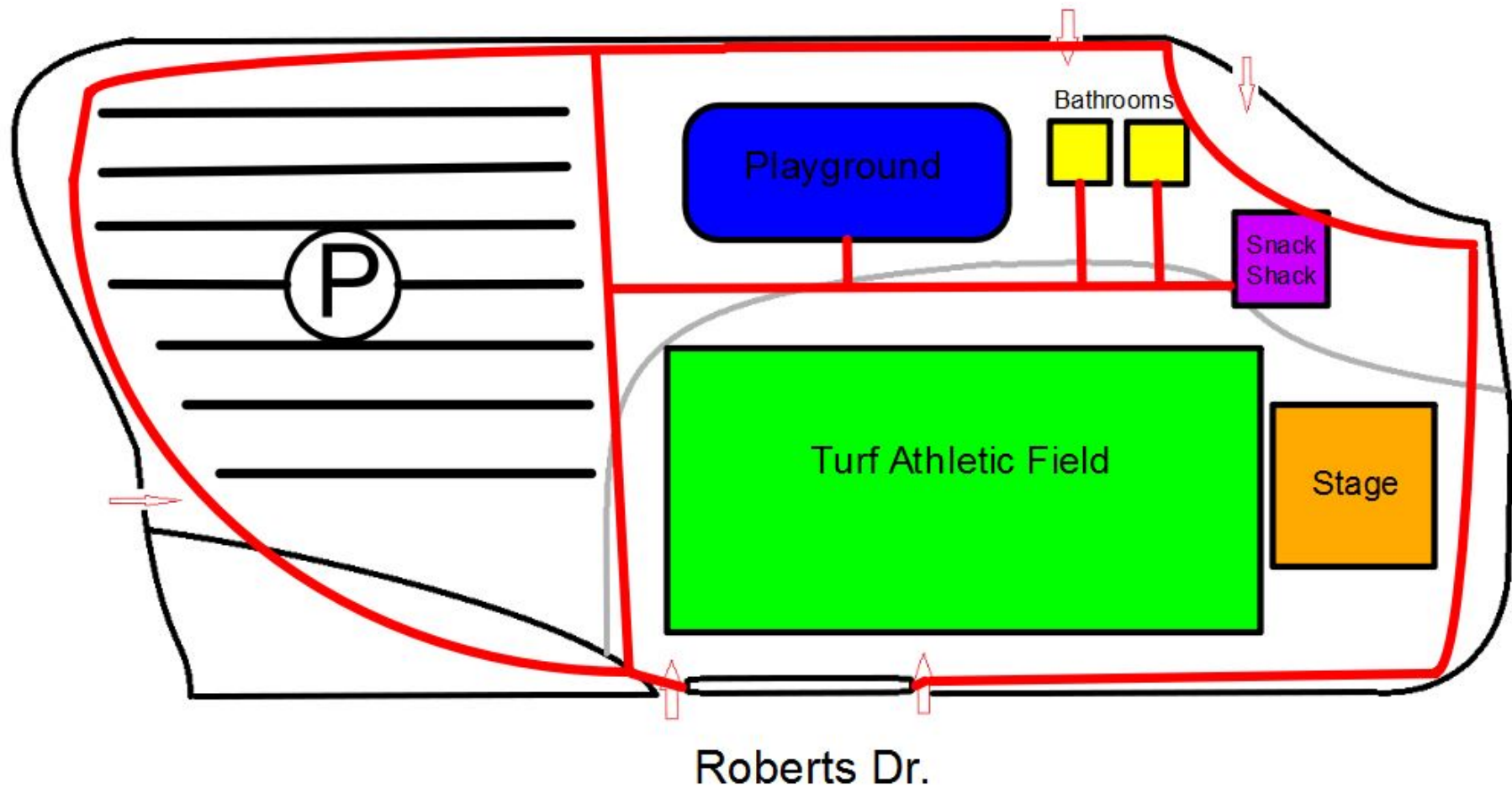

Potential Problems and Challenges

- Parking
 - At the current building, there are roughly 40 parking spaces.
- Traffic
 - At AM and PM rush hours, Roberts Drive tends to experience mild (and sometimes severe) traffic jams.
- Noise and Neighborhoods
 - The Austin site is circled by one neighborhood and is across the street from two more.
 - Proximity to neighborhoods is not necessarily a drawback, however.
- Flooding
 - Much of the proposed park area is prone to flooding

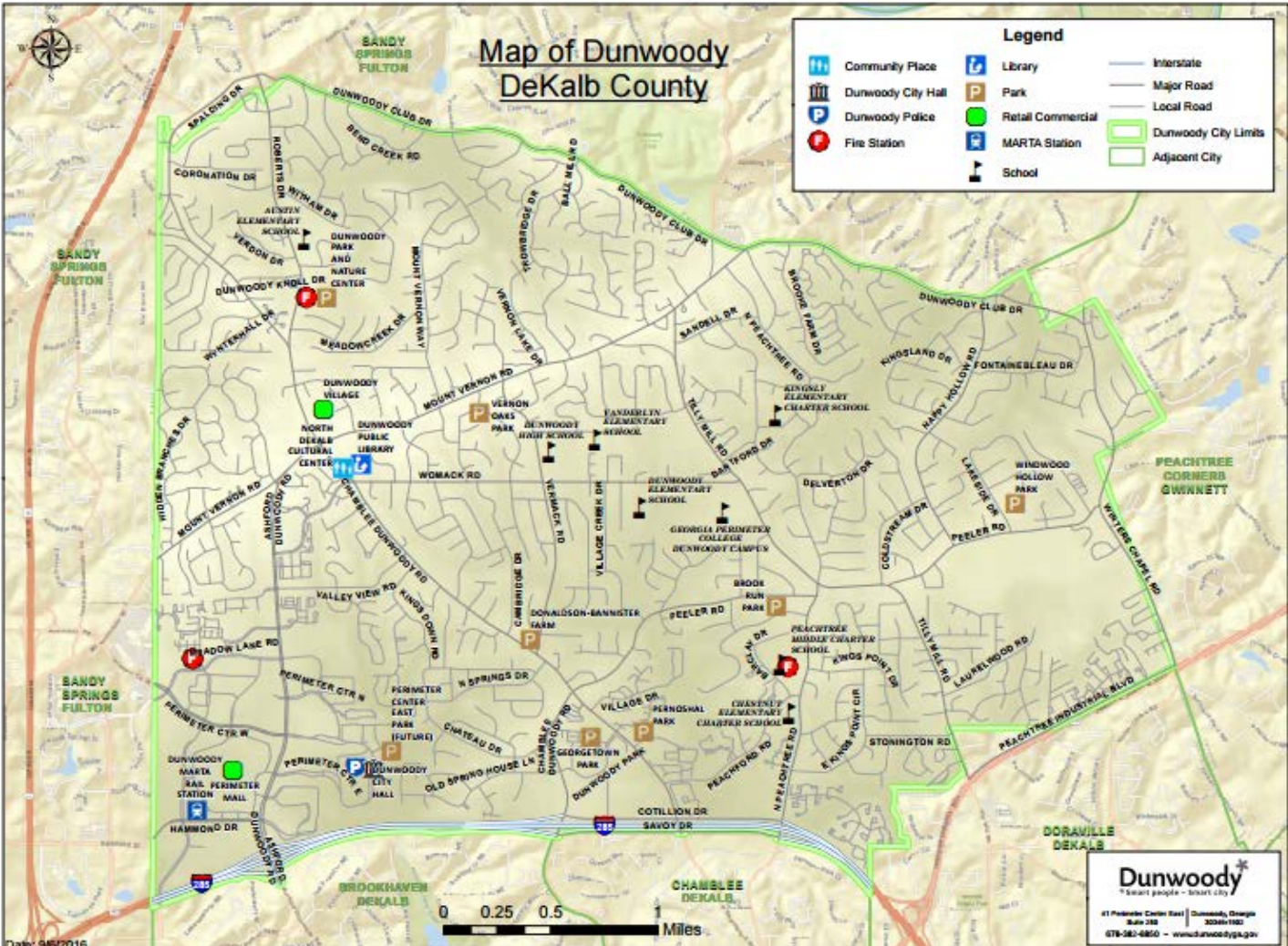
What We're Excited About!

 - Chamblee Dunwoody/Roberts Dr commercial area frequented by students

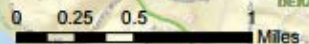
Map of Dunwoody DeKalb County
